

Leviticus 23 lists all the appointments and holy days of the Eternal.

### **Determining the Holy Days for 2026**

- No year may start in the middle of a day, even though the Spring equinox may occur in the middle of a day. Every year must start at a sunset. The first day of Spring is typically the day after the Spring equinox, at the next available sunset. The year may not start on a partial day. A partial day is when part of the day is in the Winter time and part of the day is in the Spring. This day is a day of transition, from Winter to Spring.
  The first day of Spring is not the same as the first day of the first month.
- No month may start in the middle of a day, even though the **Astronomical New-Moon Conjunction** (ANMC) may occur in the middle of a day. Every month must start at a sunset. The first day of the first month is typically the day after the new moon conjunction, at the next available sunset. The month may not start on a partial day. A partial day is when part of the day is in the prior month and part of the day is in the following month.
- No week may start in the middle of a day, the week begins at sunset of the seventh day Sabbath.

  Every week must start at a sunset. The first day of the biblical week is the day after the weekly Sabbath day ends at sunset.
- Every day starts and ends at sunset per the biblical day definition. The week starts with the sunset at the end of the Sabbath. (Leviticus 23:32: ". . . From evening to evening, you shall celebrate your Sabbath.")
- God's people have always been taught that God starts the year in the Spring. Spring starts after the *Spring equinox*. The Spring equinox is an astronomical marker that indicates the end of the Winter season and the beginning of the Spring season of the year. The *first day of Spring* usually starts at sunset after the day of the Spring equinox.
- The only option is to start the month with the sunset after the **ANMC**. Starting the month before the new moon conjunction will be using part of the prior lunation. The **ANMC** is an astronomical marker that indicates the end of a month and the beginning of a new month. In the Hebrew language the first day of the month is called *chodesh*. The whole lunar month, or lunation, is also called *chodesh*.
- Jerusalem is the *benchmark location* for all astronomical events: the Spring equinox, the start of the year, the first month of the year and the seventh month of the year.

  Sunset times in Jerusalem around the Spring and the Autumn equinoxes are always going to be between 5:00 PM. and 7:00 PM., as they are in most other places at those times of the year.
- The state of the barley in Israel plays absolutely no part in the determination of the calendar. Except that the year must start late enough so that the barley is mature enough by the Sunday during the Days of Unleavened Bread to be available for the wave sheaf offering (Leviticus 23:10-14).

The **Leviticus 23 Year (L23Y)** must never start in the winter to take care of this requirement.





### **Sources of Astronomical Data**

■ Accurate dates and times for the Spring and Autumn equinoxes information are readily available. There are a number of different sources (NASA websites, time-and-date websites and various other websites, various almanacs, various software applications, etc.) and they are all accurate to within a couple of minutes of each other.

- Accurate new moon and length of lunations information can be readily obtained by anyone today from a number of different sources (NASA websites, time and date websites, various other informational websites, various almanacs, and various software applications, etc.) and they are all accurate to within a couple of minutes from each other. These minor variations are not significant for an accurate determination.
- The times shown may be expressed in Jerusalem time (JT), which is 2 hours and 21 minutes ahead of UTC (GMT) because the city of Jerusalem is east of the Greenwich Meridian.
  - That is, for example 12:00 Noon **UTC** time corresponds to 14:21 Jerusalem time, abbreviated **JT**.
- Time of 2026 Spring Equinox: Friday, March 20, 2026, at 2:46 PM. **UTC**, before sunset. Adding 2 hours and 21 minutes we have 5:07 PM. Jerusalem Time (**JT**); which will be on Friday, March 20, 2026.
- The First day of the Spring season of the year would start at the next available sunset, which would be Sabbath, March 21, 2026 sunset, around 6:00 p.m. **JT**, until Sunday, March 22, 2026 sunset.
- The first new moon after the first day of Spring for 2026 in Jerusalem would be: Friday, April 17, 2026 at 2:13 PM **JT** (Jerusalem Time). This time is before sunset. The next available sunset is on Sabbath, April 18, 2026.

  Thus, the first day of the first month goes from sunset Friday, April 17, 2026 until sunset Sabbath, April 18, 2026.
- Next, we apply the instructions in Leviticus 23 to determine the dates for the *Passover Day*, the *Night to be Much Observed*, the *(chag) Feast of Unleavened Bread* and the *Chag Feast of Weeks*, or Pentecost.

#### **■ Passover Day:**

Passover day is on the 14th day of the first month: Friday, May 1, 2026. Passover service is on Thursday, April 30, 2026 after sunset, as the day starts at sunset; this is the 14th day of the first month at evening.

#### **■** Feast of Unleavened Bread:

The First day of Unleavened Bread is on the 15th day of first month: Sabbath, May 2, 2026.

■ The Night to be Much Observed (NTBMO) is on Friday, May 1, 2026 after sunset, as the day starts at sunset; this is the beginning of the 15th day of the first month at evening.

## Dates of the Holy Days for 2026

#### ■ Feast of Unleavened Bread:

The First day of the (chag) Feast of Unleavened Bread is on the 15th day of first month: Sabbath, May 2, 2026.

- The Night to be Much Observed (NTBMO) is on Friday, May 1, 2026 after sunset, which really is the beginning of the 15th day of the first month at evening.
- The Last day the (chag) **Feast Unleavened Bread** is on the 21st day of the first month: Friday, May 8, 2026.
- **■** Feast of Weeks, or Pentecost:

The day of the (chaq) Feast of Weeks, or **Pentecost**, is on Sunday, June 21, 2026.

- The new moon time of the seventh month of the year is on Sabbath, October 10, 2026 at 3:50 PM, **UTC**, which is October 11, 2026, 6:11 PM, Jerusalem Time (**JT**); for this is the seventh new moon conjunction of the year. The next available sunset will be on the next day, Sunday, October 11, 2026 after 6:00 PM, sunset.
- The first day of the seventh month goes from sunset Sunday, October 11, 2026, after sunset, until Monday, October 12, 2026, at sunset. This is the first day of the seventh month, as well as, the **Holy Day of Trumpets**.
- Next, we apply the instructions in Leviticus 23 to determine the dates for the *Day of Trumpets*, the *Day of Atonement*, the *(chag) Feast of Tabernacles*, and the *Last Great Day or Eighth Day of the Feast.*

### ■ Day of Trumpets:

The Day of Trumpets: Monday, October 12, 2026.

### **Day of Atonement:**

The Day of Atonement is on the 10th day of the seventh month.

Day of Atonement: Wednesday, October 21, 2026.

#### **■** Feast of Tabernacles:

The seven days of the (chag) **Feast of Tabernacles** are from the 15th day to the 21st day of the seventh month. Monday, October 26, 2026 — Sunday, November 1, 2026.

**First day** of the Feast of Tabernacles: Monday, October 26, 2026.

**Seventh day** of the Feast of Tabernacles: Sunday, November 1, 2026.

- Eighth Day of the Feast, or Last Great day: Monday, November 2, 2026.
- **Note:** Because the calendar dates are determined *solely* from astronomical data, this calendar may be referred to as an "Astronomy-Based Calendar (ABC)." No calculations are required to create an ABC.
